Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner – Vijay Kumar @ Giani son of Surjit Singh in case FIR No. 96, dated 25.07.2014, under Sections 364, 392, 394 IPC (Sections 201/34 IPC and 25 of the Arms Act were added later on), registered at Police Station Model Town, District Ludhiana City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner is in custody since 19.01.2019 and remaining co-accused after trial have already been acquitted by the trial Judge. The trial of the case to take some more time, so he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel opposed the prayer for bail on the ground that previous conduct of the petitioner that he was declared proclaimed offender by the trial Court on 22.08.2016 and avoided the process of the court for more than 2-1/2 years.

Having considered the above facts that petitioner is in custody since 19.01.2019 and co-accused have already been acquitted after trial; the trial of the case still to take some more time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner – Vijay Kumar @ Giani, is ordered to be admitted to regular bail on his furnishing adequate bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Judge/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
