Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.67 dated 15.11.2018, registered at Police Station City Morinda, District Rupnagar, under Sections 406, 419, 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and complainant has also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

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State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been registered on the application of complainant in which he alleged that accused-Balwinder Kaur and Davinder Singh had entered into an agreement to sell with him and received an amount of Rs.60 lakh. As per the prosecution version, present petitioner-Gurpreet Singh Dhanoa impersonated Davinder Singh and even Mohinder Kaur was also impersonated by some other accused.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
