This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.45 dated 28.03.2018, registered at Police Station Division E, Police Commissionerate, Amritsar, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC.

Vide order dated 03.05.2018, the petitioners were granted interim anticipatory bail and directed to join the investigation. Mr. Karanbir Singh, AAG, Punjab on instructions from Inspector Ravi Dutt states that petitioner No.1 has been found to be innocent. Petitioner No.2 has joined the investigation. His further custodial interrogation is not required.

In this view of the matter, the petition is allowed. The order dated 03.05.2018 granting interim anticipatory bail, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
