The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 2.2.2018 passed by this Court in Crl. Misc. No. M-49277 of 2017. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No. 2 to enquire into the said representation (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate action in accordance with law, in case commission of any cognizable offence is made out within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”

Compliance report by way of affidavit of Dinkar Gupta, IPS,

Director General of Police, Punjab dated 23.7.2019 has been filed. Along

with the reply, order dated 22.7.2019 has been annexed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the affidavit and the order passed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition, however, he seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the order dated 22.7.2019.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty aforesaid.
