The petitioner inter alia has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus restraining the respondents to get the physical possession of mortgaged property as the said property is the only residential house of the petitioner and to decide the representation dated 11.01.2019 (Annexure P-5) filed by the petitioner.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Bank by filing a detailed and comprehensive representation or to take recourse to the alternative remedies, as are available to him, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
