The petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.55 dated 30.09.2017, registered under Sections 323, 377, 406, 498-A, 506, 34, 294, 354, 376 IPC, at Police Station Women Police Station Sonipat, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are old aged persons and no specific role was entrusted to them.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioners have joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from them and they are no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case and considering the age of the petitioners, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 16.01.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
