GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. It is not disputed that there is a dispute regarding inheritance as regards property of petitioner's father namely Harbhajan Singh who is survived by his widow, 2 daughters including the petitioner and one son. Learned counsel has submitted that although the petitioner's father initially owned 46 'marlas' of land but the present dispute that survives is as regards 299 square yards regarding which a civil suit is also pending. Learned counsel has submitted that respondent No.4 has been pressuring the petitioner to withdraw the civil suit and to effect a compromise. Learned counsel has submitted that although the petitioner as well as her

husband had been giving beatings and they had got themselves medico legally examined but police did not take any action despite the fact that a representation dated 13.9.2018 (Annexure P-8) had also been moved.

2. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-8) expeditiously and in case, the allegations made therein are found to be well-founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.
3. A copy of this order along with copy of the representation (Annexure P-8) be sent to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
