- “i. Issue a direction or order to respondents No.1 to 3 to conclude the investigation and present the challan in FIR No.51 dated 7.6.2016 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC and appropriate legal action against the persons named in the FIR (Annexure P-1) may be taken.*
- ii. To decide the representation as moved by the petitioner (Annexure P-2).”*

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh, has submitted that after investigation, police did not find any substance in the allegations made in the First Information Report and, therefore, cancellation report has been prepared and submitted in the Court.
