Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.6 dated 12.01.2019 under Section 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 13.03.2019 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel submits that the Investigating Officer has not come present to assist him, however, he states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his

custodial interrogation is no more required and FIR has been registered under Section 498-A IPC, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 13.03.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
