Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for setting aside the order of sentence dated 25.09.2018, passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Chandigarh in case FIR No.191 dated 23.09.2018, under Section 68 (1) (b) of the Punjab Police Act, 2007 and Section 510 IPC registered at Police Station Sector-3, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to the remedy of filing an appeal before learned Additional Sessions Judge, Chandigarh.

Dismissed as withdrawn, as prayed for with the liberty aforesaid.

It is clarified that the point of limitation shall be considered by learned Appellate Court by taking into consideration the fact that petitioner has been pursuing the matter before this Court.

Keeping in view the controversy and career of the petitioner, learned Appellate Court is requested that in case the appeal is preferred within one week from today, the same be considered and decided expeditiously, preferably within four weeks in accordance with law.
