This order shall dispose of the above mentioned two petitions
as the same have arisen out of one FIR and point for determination in both
these petitions is one and the same.

CRM-M-13719-2019**

Prayer in these petitions is for quashing of FIR No.173 dated 20.04.2009, registered under Sections 419, 420 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Sector 34, Chandigarh, alongwith all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom, as well as for setting aside the order dated 29.10.2019 (Annexure P-4), vide which the petitioners have been declared as proclaimed offenders.

Vide order dated 09.04.2019, the petitioners were directed to appear before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from that day and the trial Court would release them on their furnishing bail/surety bonds subject to its satisfaction and on deposit of Rs.25,000/- each with the District Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contend that in compliance of the order dated 09.04.2019, the petitioners have appeared before the trial Court and the amount of Rs.25,000/- each has been deposited with the District Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh.

Learned Addl. P.P. U.T. Chandigarh, on instructions from SI Krishan Kumar, submits that the petitioners have been regularly appearing before the trial Court.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 09.04.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.
