The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in DDR No.41 dated 08.08.2018 under Sections 326, 324, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sudhar, District Ludhiana in case FIR No.109 dated 08.08.2018 under Sections 354-A, 324, 323, 506, 427, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sudhar, District Ludhiana.

The petitioner is in custody since 05.01.2019. The trial of the

case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the

petitioner in custody.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Jatinder Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate and subject to payment of Rs.50,000/- to the prosecutrix as interim compensation. Trial court shall hand over the said amount to the prosecutrix. The aforesaid amount will be without prejudice to the rights of the parties and shall be subject to the final outcome of the trial. The petitioner shall also remain bound by the following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence, in accordance with law. In that eventuality, the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.
