GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.143 dated 31.12.2014 under Sections 380, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Raja Sansi, District Amritsar and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 1.3.2019 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.
3. Report of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ajnala has

been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners as well as of complainant-Sukhraj Singh have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that the complainant has no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Magistrate that the matter has been compromised with the free and voluntary consent of the complainant and the accused.

4. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.143 dated 31.12.2014 under Sections 380, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Raja Sansi, District Amritsar and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
