SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J.

None appears for the Respondent, although the office report shows that service upon her stands effected.

2. Ld. Counsel for Petitioner/JD has tendered certified copy of the order passed by the Ld. Executing Court/Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division) Khamano, on 22.08.2019, from which it transpires that the Execution Petition was sought to be withdrawn by the Decree-Holder Daljit Kaur, who had given statement to the effect that she had received the entire settled amount from the JD/Petitioner.

3. In spite of such statement, the Ld. Court below did not dispose off the pending Execution in view of stay order, passed by this Court earlier, on 11.03.2019.

4. In such situation, the present Revision has itself been rendered infructuous and therefore, stands disposed off as such.

5. Consequently, the Ld. Court below is directed to now pass an appropriate order in accordance with law, since by way of final disposal of the present Revision, the interim stay order passed on 11.3.2019 automatically stands recalled.
