This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.206 dated 06.10.2017 under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467 and 471 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Jamalpur, Ludhiana. The petitioner has already been granted anticipatory bail under Section 420 IPC in aforesaid FIR. The petitioner apprehend his arrest at the hands of Police, after addition of offences punishable under Sections 406, 465, 467 and 471 IPC.

It is not disputed that the parties have compromised and the petition for quashing i.e. CRM-M-32356-2019 is already pending for 20.09.2019.

This fact is not disputed by learned counsel representing the complainant as well as learned State counsel.

Considering the above background, it is ordered that in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. He shall join investigation as and when called for by the Investigating Officer and would abide by the conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is allowed.
