The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.1 to 3 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7, as they have married against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned State counsel has filed short affidavit dated 07.05.2019 of Ashok Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Circle Ghanaur, District Patiala on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 along with the statements (Annexures R-1 and R-2). The same are taken on record and copies of the same is given to the opposite counsel.

In the reply as well as in the statement of petitioner No.1 (Annexure R-1), it is mentioned that she solemnized love marriage with petitioner No.2 as per Hindu rites and rituals and has filed the present petition in this Court. It is further mentioned that now she is residing in her parental house at village Baghora and wants to live with her parents.

This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioners, therefore, he does not press the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
