Today, at the very outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition, at this stage, since as per knowledge of the petitioner no separate FIR under Section 174 Cr.P.C. has been lodged and that in case it is found that any such FIR is lodged, he may be permitted to approach this Court again.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of two weeks from today and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the learned trial Court shall endeavour to dispose of the same expeditiously preferably within a period of three days from filing of such application but, in any case, not later than one week.
