This petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6 as they have solemnized marriage against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned State counsel has produced a copy of the statement of petitioner No.1, namely, Baro wherein she has stated that she was forcibly taken away by petitioner No.2 and his brother. She has even denied the filing of the petition for grant of protection. A copy of the statement has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners. He does not deny the fact that the petitioners are living separately as petitioner No.1 had joined the company of her parents.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the petition.
