This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.7 dated 17.01.2018 registered under Section 22 of the N.D.P.S. Act, 1985 at Police Station S.G.N. Dev Thermal, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that a similarly situated co-accused was granted the concession of regular bail on conditions by order dated 15.02.2019 passed in CRM-M-34823-2018 (Anneuxre P-2).

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from H.C. Jagsir Singh has accepted this factual assertion.

Keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner

in the same terms as CRM-M-34823-2018. Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate in the same terms.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
