There is huge delay of 9½ years in filing first appeal before the lower Appellate Court. Though law of limitation has to be liberally construed, but the petitioner has not made out any such sufficient grounds so as to condone the aforesaid delay. Only ground set up is that the petitioner kept on approaching the Authorities. The averments are wanting in terms of date, place and number of attempts made by the petitioner during the period of 9½ years. The petitioner was reasonably expected to approach the Court after a reasonable time of six months after filing the first representation before the concerned Authority.

In view of above, no ground is made out to condone the

huge delay of 9½ years in filing the first appeal before the lower Appellate Court. This revision petition is accordingly dismissed.
