FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (Oral)

Report dated 19.01.2019 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Chandigarh has been received whereby after recording statements of victim-Monika Arora (Madan Lal Makkar complainant died) and the accused persons, namely, Mohit Sharma, Kewal Krishan and Saroj Sharma, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and

the offences for which the accused has been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 33 dated 30.01.2014 registered at Police Station A Division, District Amritsar under Section 498-A and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
