A writ of certiorari is being sought, inter alia, by the petitioner herein seeking of quashing the appointments of respondent Nos. 4, 5 and 6 on the ground that the petitioner, being more meritorious ought to have been appointed instead. The petitioner further asserts that appointment of respondent Nos. 7 to 63 be also quashed.

I have gone through the pleadings and I am of the view that by sheer efflux of time, relief sought by the petitioner herein is rendered infructuous as the writ petition was filed in the year 1996. Not only the petitioner but even the private-respondents, whose appointments were under challenge must have attained the age of superannuation.

In the premise the writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, with liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court if any cause of action still survives.

Disposed of accordingly.
