The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure (in short “Cr.P.C.”) for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0424 dated 06.12.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Section 376 of the Indian Penal Code (for short, “IPC”) and Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 at Police Station South Sector 34, Chandigarh.

Heard.

Statement of the parties have been recorded and a compromise has been effected between the parties. Both petitioner and the prosecutrix were having love affair and they want to marry each other. The petitioner is in custody since long. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful

purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Deepu Rawat son of Late Sh. Sunder Lal is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate subject to the following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437 (3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.
