GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.7 dated 18.01.2017 under Sections 323, 324, 325, 452, 427, 379-A, 148 & 149 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Rawalpindi, District Kapurthala and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 1.3.2019 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements

recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Phagwara has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners as well as of complainant-Balwinder Singh and injured – Tarlochan Singh and Kamaljit Kaur have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainant & injured have no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Magistrate that the compromise between the parties seems to be genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.
4. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.7 dated 18.01.2017 under Sections 323, 324, 325, 452, 427, 379-A, 148 & 149 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Rawalpindi, District Kapurthala and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
