By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in FIR No. 66, dated 07.03.2018, under Sections 147/149/323/325/506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 53, Gurugram, District Gurugram.

Vide order dated 23.04.2018, the petitioners were granted interimbail and directed to join investigation.

On instructions from police official, learned State counsel states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 23.04.2018 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join

the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
