Prayer is for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising out from FIR No.63, dated 07.05.2018, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Odhan, District Sirsa, Haryana.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Kulbir, has submitted that the petitioner is a previous convict under the NDPS Act. He further submits that two more criminal cases are pending against the petitioner under the Indian Penal Code. He further informs the Court that prosecution has already recorded depositions of 7 witnesses out of total 14 proposed to be examined.

Keeping in view the facts of the case and the stage of trial, this court is not inclined to grant concession of bail to the petitioner, at this stage. However, learned trial court is requested to conclude the trial expeditiously, preferably within 4 months.
