Petitioner Sunny Kumar has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the official respondents to register an FIR against the private respondents and further to search the children of the petitioner.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that respondent No.4 is wife of the petitioner and out of this wedlock two daughters were born. It is conceded that since the year 2016 the petitioner and respondent No.4-wife are living separately and she is residing with respondent No.6 along with both the daughters. The petitioner has levelled bald allegations regarding character, not only against his wife but against respondent No.5 as well, which are not worth believing in the absence of

any convincing material.

Since the petitioner is having a matrimonial dispute with his wife and the alternative remedy in law is available, therefore, no ground is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

The petition is hereby dismissed.
