INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in a complaint case No.RT/22 dated 30.10.2010 (after committal SC-97-2017 dated 12.07.2017).

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

In the present case, the petitioner has already been declared proclaimed offender. As per the version of complainant, serious allegations

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have been levelled.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the fact that the petitioner has already been declared proclaimed offender, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
