The short prayer of the petitioner herein is that the respondents be directed to release her salary for the period she was in service i.e. from the month of May, 1995 till the time she resigned in the month of July 1996.

During pendency of the writ petition, the petitioner preferred an application wherein she had prayed for directions to the respondent-School to take her back in service.

Without adverting on the merits of the said application, suffice to rely on the stand taken in para 4 of the reply to the writ petition, which read as under:-

"It is further submitted that the respondents have been willing and ready to pay the arrears of salary of the petitioner w.e.f 01/06/1995 to 29/07//1996 at consolidated salary of Rs.2200/-p.m. As part time

Lecturer which on calculation comes to Rs.17,696/-. The petitioner was appointed as part-time Lecturer w.e.f. 01/08/1994 by the management, with her consent. The letter dated 01/08/1994 issued by the management of the answering respondent College to the petitioner is annexed with the reply as Annexure R-1 showing the petitioner as part time Lecturer.”

In view of the aforesaid candid and conceded position writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.3 and 4 to disburse the arrears of salary to the petitioner w.e.f 01.06.1995 to 29.07.1996 at a consolidated salary of Rs.2200/- per month for the period she had rendered her services as part time Lecturer along with interest @ 8% per annum with effect from the date i.e. 01.06.1995 till the actual date of disbursement.

Disposed of in above terms.
