This petition has been filed for quashing of the order dated 27.4.2011 vide which the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender in FIR No. 157 dated 8.6.2010 under Sections 307, 326, 324, 323, 452, 506, 148, 149, 120-B IPC at P.S Nakodar, District Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner has stated that at the time when the FIR was registered and even till date the petitioner is residing abroad. FIR was registered on 8.6.2010 and the petitioner has been residing in abroad since 2006. He further has stated that all the accused in this case have been acquitted and the petitioner is ready to face trial.

Learned DAG on instructions from ASI Harbhajan Lal has accepted these assertions.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to reject the prayer. Resultantly, the order dated 27.4.2011 vide which the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender is quashed.

Let the petitioner appear before the Trial Court within two months and face the proceedings.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
