AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 30.5.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 14096 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 2 to objectively consider the representation dated 10.11.2017 (Annexure P-7) and pass a speaking order thereupon, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

Learned counsel for the respondent has produced copy of order dated 21.8.2019 passed by Director Elementary Education, Haryana rejecting the claim of the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the order, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, he seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the order dated 21.8.2019.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
