The contempt petition has been filed stating that there was intentional disobedience of the order dated 1.12.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M-53017 of 2018.

On 15.5.2019, this Court passed the order, the operative part of which is reproduced below:

“Let, Superintendent of Police, Palwal to look into this aspect and accordingly provide protection to the petitioner, if so required for her staying in the village. However, the petitioner shall contact Superintendent of Police, Palwal on his mobile No. 8814000400 to inform him about her whereabouts and thereafter S. P. Palwal shall organize for her to come present in her village.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the orders dated 1.12.2018 and 15.5.2019 have been complied with.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, no further interference is called for in the present petition.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.
