The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.55, dated 24.4.2018, registered under Sections 302, 34 of the IPC, at Police Station Nathusarai Chopta, District Sirsa.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the present petition be disposed of in the same terms as that of co-accused Amit Kumar, namely, CRM-M No.5863 of 2019 which was disposed of by order dated 27.2.2019.

Learned AAG Haryana, on instructions from SI Mahan Singh, has fairly stated that the case of the petitioner is similar to that of his co-accused Amit Kumar, since both of them jointly accused of having murdered the deceased.

In these circumstances, this petition is disposed of in the same

terms as in CRM-M No.5863 of 2019.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
