This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 158 dated 11.7.2018 registered under Sections 406/420/506/120-B IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professional Regulation Act 2014 and under Section 24 of Immigration Act 1983 at PS Division 6, Jalandhar.

Pursuant to the order dated 23.5.2019, counsel for the petitioner has handed over Rs.1,25,000/- by way of draft to the learned counsel for the complainant and prays that he will hand over the remaining amount of Rs. 1,00,000/- on 31.5.2019.

Prayer is allowed. Let the petitioner appear before

Investigating Officer on 31.5.2019 and handed over the remaining amount of Rs.1 lakhs (for disbursal to the complainant), if the petitioner make the remaining payment his bail would be confirmed and if the petitioner does not make the payment interim bail would be vacated.

Resultantly, the petition stands allowed in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
