Under challenge herein is punishment order dated 18.01.1996 (Annexure P-11) which was upheld vide appellate order dated 04.03.1996 (Annexure P-12).

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 09.07.2019 when the matter was taken up, none appeared for the parties and this Court had directed issuance of fresh notice to the respective parties through their respective counsels.

3. Office report reflects that e-mails were sent to all the respective learned counsels and yet none appears.

4. Having perused the pleadings, I am of the view that, even otherwise, the nature of relief, as sought by the petitioner in the present petition, by sheer efflux of time has been rendered infructuous as he would be currently 60 years and would have superannuated from service.

5. In the premise, writ petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file an appropriate application, if so advised.
