The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 494 dated 28.3.2013 under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-34, Chandigarh and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

At this stage, learned counsel for Punjab National Bank-respondent No. 2 has stated that as per the terms and conditions, the requisite amount has been paid by the petitioners and the title deeds have also been returned.
