Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr. P.C.') for directing the respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and to take appropriate action against respondent No.4, on the basis of complaint dated 29.01.2019 (Annexure P-2).

In response to the notice of motion issued by this Court, reply by way of affidavit of Dr. Manpreet Shinhmar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Investigation, Amritsar (Rural) has been filed by learned State counsel, today in Court and the same is taken on record.

Perusal of paragraph-6 (preliminary submissions) reveals that in a case under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 (for short 'NI Act') filed by the petitioner, respondent No.4 was declared as proclaimed person and thereafter arrested on 03.04.2019, however, released on bail. It is further submitted in the reply that no complaint dated 29.01.2019 as alleged by the petitioner, has been received by the police.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be

issued in the matter.

Petition stands disposed off, accordingly.

However, it is clarified that if the petitioner still feels aggrieved, he may take recourse to the remedy available under law.
