This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.5 dated 18.1.2019 registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC and Section 13 (1) (d) of PC Act, at PS Maloya, UT Chandigarh.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he had duped the complainant with an amount of Rs.1 lakh by promising that he would arrange job for his son in police department.

Learned Standing Counsel on instructions from SI Ashwani Kumar has stated that money has to be recovered from the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has then argued that apart from the bald statement of the complainant there is no other evidence which may prove that the complainant had ever paid money to the petitioner. He

however offered that petitioner would deposit a sum of Rs. 1 lakh with the Registrar General of this Court and the same may be released to the party whoever be successful in this litigation.

I find the offer of the petitioner very fair. Let the petitioner deposit a sum of Rs.1 lakh by way of draft in the name of the Registrar General of this Court within 15 days from today. The Registrar General will put the same in the long term fixed deposit in any nationalized bank and it be released to the party which get success in this litigation. Thereafter, after the deposit of Rs.1 lakh the petitioner would appear before the IO with proof of deposit of Rs. 1 lakh and he will be released on bail by the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
