Reply by way of short affidavit dated 02.05.2019 of the Joint Director, Department of Local Government, Punjab along with Annexure R-1/T has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.

Complete copy thereof has been furnished to counsel opposite.

Petitioner is serving on the post of Assistant Municipal Engineer under the Department of Local Bodies, State of Punjab.

Challenge in the instant petition is to the order dated 20.02.2019 (Annexure P-1) whereby the petitioner has been transferred from Ropar to Sahnewal (Ludhiana).

The entire case projected on behalf of the petitioner was that he is a victim of frequent transfers i.e. having suffered 9 transfers within a time frame of 3 ½ years.

In the reply that has been filed in Court today, it has been stated

that the impugned transfer order qua the petitioner has already been withdrawn vide letter dated 08.03.2019 (appended as Annexure R-1/T along with the written statement) and that the petitioner continues to serve at Municipal Council, Ropar.

In the light of such categoric stand taken on behalf of the State Government, writ petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.
