The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, inter alia, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the notice dated 02.02.2019 (Annexure P-3) and further directing respondent-bank to grant three months' more time for depositing the entire amount/complying with the settlement dated 20.12.2018 (Annexure P-1).

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that inadvertently certain facts and essential documents could not be appended with the writ petition. Accordingly, prayer was made that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh one on the same cause of action with better particulars.
