Petitioner herein is complainant in complaint titled as “Kailash Chand v. Rajesh Kumar”. The short grievance of the petitioner is that accused in the complaint case under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 has already been declared as proclaimed offender but he has not been arrested, though he is available at the address given.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that for redressal of his grievance, petitioner made a representation dated 23.08.2016 (Annexure P3) to Superintendent of Police, Narnaul, but the same still remained pending adjudication.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 6. A complete copy of paper-book be provided to him during the course of the day.

In view of above, present petition stands disposed of with the directions to respondent No.5-Superintendent of Police, District Mahendergarh at Narnaul to take the required action on the representation dated 23.08.2016 (Annexure P3), expeditiously and preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
