This order shall dispose of above mentioned three petitions.

These petitions have been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner/s in case F.I.R. No.12 dated 05.02.2016 registered under Sections 307/224/225/148/149/120-B IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Nawanshahar, District Shahid Bhagat Singh Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner/s state that similarly situated co-accused who had under gone lesser sentence were granted concession of regular bail.

Custody certificates dated 14.05.2019 filed by way of affidavit of respective Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail on behalf of State have been filed and the same are taken on record. Copies supplied to counsel opposite.

As per the custody certificates the petitioner-Manpreet Singh @ Mani has been in custody for 02 years, 08 months & 05 days, the petitioner-Gurpreet Singh @ Laddi has been in custody for 08 months & 19 days and the petitioner-Jagdeep Singh @ Judge has been in custody for 03 years, 01 month & 25 days.

Counsel for the petitioner/s state that the main accused who had fired and the person who had aided to escape him are in custody.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Balbeg Singh has accepted that the co-accused have been granted the concession of regular bail.

In the circumstances, I see no reason to take a different view for the petitioner/s and consequently, grant them the concession of regular bail in the same terms as in the above mentioned case.

Petitions stand allowed.

Since the main cases have been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
