This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.26 dated 26.04.2018 registered under Sections 307/34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act and Sections 120-B IPC and Sections 54 & 59-A of the Arms Act (added later on) at Police Station Mehta, District Amritsar Rural.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the named accused has been acquitted by order dated 03.12.2018 (Annexure P-2) because the complainant has resiled from his statement.

Custody certificate filed in Court dated 12.03.2019 by way of affidavit of Balwinder Singh, Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar on behalf of Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar is taken on record. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner has undergone more than 3 months

of custody.

Keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Illaqa Magistrate/C.J.M/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
