Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct detailed/fair enquiry on the complaints (Annexures P-1 and P-2) given by the petitioners and to take legal action against the respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that despite there being a complaint/representation (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner on 04.02.2019 against respondent No.4, no action thereof has been taken by the police on the said representation.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Jagmohan Ghumman, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of official respondents No.1 to 3.
