GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. By way of filing this petition, the petitioner prays for issuance of direction to conduct fair and proper inquiry in his complaints and representations pertaining to the threats and harassment met out to him at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is NRI who had spent a good 8/9 years in Australia and during which period he had been sending his earnings to his family but after he returned back from Australia, his father and brother have not given his share in the investments made out of the earnings sent by him and in fact they have even tried to falsely get him

implicated in a kidnapping case and also in a theft case, which was duly investigated by the police and wherein allegations were found to be false.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Deputy Superintendent of Police (NRI Department), Ludhiana to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-1) expeditiously and in case, the allegations made therein are found to be well-founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.
4. A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-1) be sent to respondent No.3- Deputy Superintendent of Police (NRI Department), Ludhiana so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
