Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 & 3 to decide the representation dated 13.12.2017 (P-8) as per law.

In response to the notice of motion, issued by this Court, reply by way of affidavit dated 29.06.2018 of Sh. Navjot Singh Mahal, SSP, Police District Khanna has been filed in the Registry of this Court. The same is taken on record.

Perusal of paragraph 7 of the affidavit reveals that after the settlement of the matter, the cheque bearing No.39854 for an amount of ₹ 1,25,580/- was offered to the petitioner, but he did not accept the same.

Now, during the course of hearing, both the parties have agreed that in case the cheque for the aforesaid amount is handed over to the petitioner, he will be satisfied, provided the said cheque is valid.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent Nos.4 and 5 to hand over a demand draft to the petitioner for an amount of ₹ 1,25,580/- within a period of four weeks from today.
