The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to official respondents No.1 to 3 to provide protection to the lives land liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No. 4 and 5.

The case of the petitioners is that they have solemnized the marriage against the wishes of the private respondents and hence, they apprehending danger to their lives from them.

It has been averred in the petition that both the petitioners are major. Mr. S.S. Samu, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.4 and has filed his power of attorney, which is taken on record. Learned counsel submits that petitioner No.1 is the daughter of respondent No.4 and as per the Aadhar Card and School Certificate of 8th Class, photocopies of which are taken on record, her date of birth is 25.8.2002. Accordingly, she is about 16 and a half years of age.

Both the petitioners and respondent No.4 are present in Court. On

asking, petitioner No.1 states that she wishes to go along with her father.

Petitioner No.2 has no objection to the same.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 undertakes that neither respondent No.4 nor any other family member would initiate any proceedings against petitioner No.2 in respect of the present marriage regarding which no proof has been placed on record.

Petitioner No.2 undertakes that he will not interfere or intermeddle with the life of petitioner No.1 nor try to contact her henceforth.

In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed.

The present petition is disposed of.
