This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 262 dated 17.12.2018 registered under Sections 61/1 of Excise Act, 1914 and 420, 120-B IPC, 1860 at PS Chheharta, Amritsar.

After arguing for some time and realising that this Court is not inclined to give any relief to the petitioner learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw this petition. He stated that he would surrender before the Court and move an application for regular bail and pray that the same be decided expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. The petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with the observation that the petitioner would surrender on or before 15.3.2019 and move an application for regular bail and the same be decided on merits expeditiously but in any case on or before 19.3.2019.

Since the main case has been dismissed as withdrawn, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands dismissed as withdrawn.
