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**RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (ORAL):**

By the passage of about two decades, this petition has apparently been rendered infructuous.

The petitioner has challenged the order dated 09.06.2000, by which his appointment as a notary was withdrawn. The case was admitted on 29.01.2001, without any interim order. An amount of Rs.1000/- furnished by the petitioner by way of a demand draft drawn on the State Bank of India was returned by the Government of India, vide its letter dated 09.06.2000 (Annexure R1). The letter records that the letter of appointment dated 22.11.1999 was issued inadvertently. It is too late to intervene in the matter.

The petition stands dismissed.
