Present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.121 dated 10.07.2018 under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 13 of the Travel Professional Regulation Act, 2014, registered at Police Station Division No.1, Jalandhar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Pal Singh, contended that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and is not required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 05.03.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
